Please find below detailed and important information in regard to the 'Call Up' Process at Mount Hamilton Youth Soccer Club (MHYSC). Please remember that we are United as a club and must always do our best to work together with coaches and programs within MHYSC to ensure that everyone is successful in everything that we do.

Academy Program u8 – u12:

- Grassroots Age Groups are not permitted to call a player up from the age group below
- Grassroots Age Groups are permitted to move a player laterally from the same age group within the Recreational Program
- A Recreational Player that moves laterally to play a game must be carded by the Club and District which takes approximately 2 weeks
- This player is not permitted to play within the Recreational Program Game that week and must comply with the Ontario Soccer Development Matrix
- It is suggested that if an Age Group is going to call up a recreational player that they purchase a home and away kit to ensure this player is wearing the correct uniform
- A lateral movement must be discussed and cleared with the Technical Director prior to it happening. This will allow the Technical Director to communicate with all other parties involved
- The Technical Director must approve a Recreational player training with the Academy prior to a call up, to ensure the Club is aware and the player is covered under the Club's Insurance Policy

U13 – U18 Competitive Program:

- The Head Coach of the team looking for a call up should email the Head Coach of the team they are looking for a call up from
- The Technical Director must be ccd on this email
- Within the email the Head Coach should request a player that plays in a specific position, not a specific player
- Call ups should only be required if a team is dropping below 14 players for a game
- If there is a game conflict between the two teams, then there will be no option of a call up
- If a coach refuses another team a call up player, this must be discussed with the Technical Director and valid rationale must be provided
- The Coach receiving the email is asked to respond accordingly within 24 hours of receiving the request

- A call up request must be made no later than 72 hours prior to a game. If there are extenuating circumstances, there must be a discussion with the Technical Director to facilitate this request
- U13 Teams cannot call up from the U12 Academy Program
- A U13 MJ Team can only call up a player from the U13 Recreational Program
- A Recreational Player that is called up to play a game must be carded by the Club and District which takes approximately 2 weeks
- It is suggested that if an Age Group is going to call up a recreational player that they purchase a home and away kit to ensure this player is wearing the correct uniform
- Hamilton United U13-u18 Regional Teams can call up from the u13-u18 MHYSC MJ team, when this is possible within the club
- MJ teams can call up from the Age Group below from another District Team at MHYSC
- The Technical Director must approve a Recreational player training with the MJ team prior to a call up, to ensure the Club is aware and that the player is covered under the Club's insurance policy.
- The Technical Director must approve a competitive player training with another competitive team prior to a call up, to ensure the Club is aware and that the player is covered under the Club's Insurance Policy
